Week One: June 9 - 13 Magic Forest

HALF and FULL DAY

We will transform the Arboretum into a magical forest where all kinds of fun things will happen. Campers will use their imagination as they enter forest for fun adventures. Learning how to do magic tricks; play unusual games; solve mysteries and puzzles; and learn how to create some great potions are all part of this fun week. We will also learn about the magical creatures that are in fantasy stories or taken from some well-known characters seen on TV.

Week Two: June 16 - 20 Summer Safari Nature Week

HALF and FULL DAY

Wildlife is everywhere in our nature center. All you must do is go exploring and look closely to find it! Nature week takes campers exploring to learn about the amazing secrets of nature. Campers will enjoy looking, collecting and identifying the many forms of wildlife found throughout the center. We will go on scavenger hunts, catch insects, and explore the Arboretum's many habitats to find out what lives in our woods, ponds and fields. A great week of nature games, education about nature, and lots of fun.

Week Three: June 23 – 27 Eye Spy Detective

HALF and FULL DAY

This week the campers are asked to become detectives and try to use the clues to solve the mysteries of the Althouse Arboretum Island. Kids will be able to learn and advance their spy skills by identifying fingerprints, solving crime scenes, and playing outdoor games that require problem solving skills. We love testing their mental and physical abilities on our famous obstacle course. Mysteries involved allow kids to play a real-life version of the game "Clue" with crimes like the "Pool-Noodle Thief". Loads of fun and creativity will be found during this week!

Week Four: July 7 - 11 Space Explorers

HALF and FULL DAY

We added a completely new and exciting week. Space Explores starts with the earth, moves to the sky, and then its off to outer space! Join us on an imaginary adventure to space where we will visit planets, and distant galaxies. Campers will learn some of the fascinating things about living and traveling in space. There are so many fun and exciting activities planned for this week – including our own miniature planetarium!

Week Five: July 14 – 18 Mad Scientist HALF and FULL DAY

This hands-on week gives campers the opportunity to investigate, examine, and observe how science is involved with many aspects of our natural world. This week also tests the kids' listening skills and allows them to experience more hands-on learning in nature during the summer months.

Week Seven: July 28- August 1 Splish Splash HALF and FULL DAY

Be ready to get wet as we dive into water week! We will learn about our oceans, but also explore streams, ponds, and the creatures that live there! Enjoy a cooling off during the hot summer months with activities designed to get you wet. This week will include a look into water pollution, conservation, and the water cycle through fun games and activities.. Don't forget your bathing suit because we will be getting wet with water games and water activities.
